POSTER JUDGING CRITERIA – ORIGINAL RESEARCH

FORMAT AND CONTENT (PER ABSTRACT GUIDELINES)

- Background includes a hypothesis that is clearly stated.
- Methods are reproducible.
- Data analysis and results are appropriate and clear.
- Conclusions match the results.
- Acknowledgments are included:
 - Study sponsors and grants
 - IRB statement

RELEVANCE

- Relevance for the osteopathic family physician.
- Clinical relevance

ORAL PRESENTATIONS

- The presenter is knowledgeable about the topic.
- The presenter is knowledgeable about research.
- The presenter is able to answer questions.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- The use of any additional materials or equipment during the oral presentation requires advanced approval.
