Healthcare workers described risk-based screening prior to the WHO HIV testing guideline update that considers the patient's:

- Family history: reported positive parental HIV status, parental death of unknown cause
- Lack of expected improvement to medical treatment
- Poor growth
- Need for surgery

Providers consistently mentioned lack of personnel, equipment, and private spaces as barriers to HIV testing
