Service Integration Level (SIL)	Clinical Risk Group (CRG)	Other Factors
1	1-5a	No Substance Use disorder, Serious Emotional Disturbance, or Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome
2	5b/6	Meets CRG or has either serious emotional disturbance, substance use disorder, or neonatal abstinence syndrome
3	7, 8, 9	Department of Children and Family Services care, Claims for > 20 days in the hospital or nursing home in the past year, or current nursing home placement
