Dermatology	Group lecture, 1 hour	Newborn rashes, acne, eczema, hemangiomas	Rashes in skin of different Fitzpatrick scales. First steps of acne management. Mild to moderate eczema care. Topical propranolol administration, reasons for urgent hemangioma dermatology referral.
