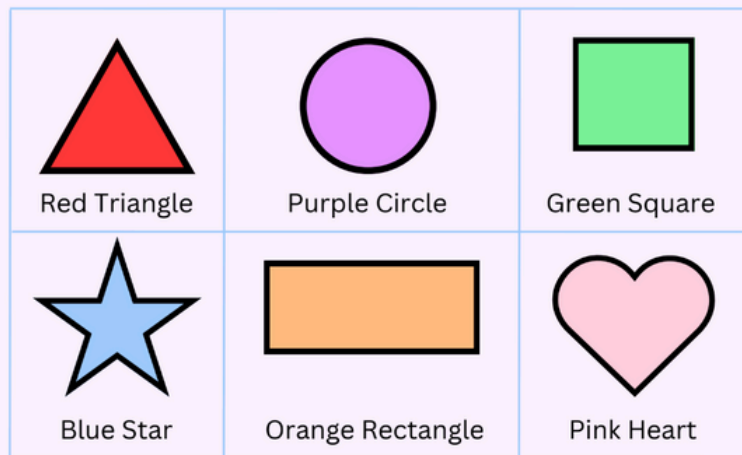


Scavenger Hunt

Hey parents/ guardians! Talk to your kids about the shapes below. Find each shape around the clinic and teach them about the shapes, colors, etc.

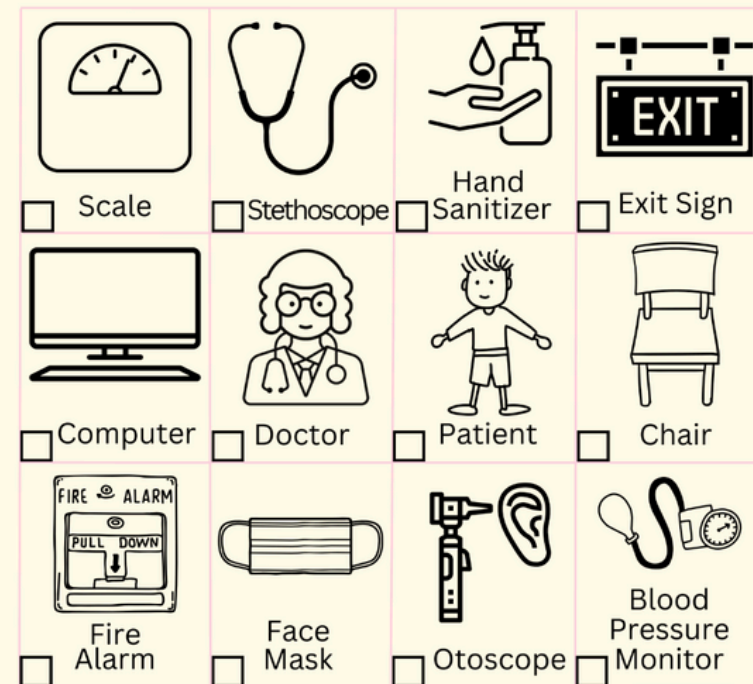
