	Criteria
Gold Standard	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Fully adherent to I-PASS format- No missing or redundant information- Leads with a clear understanding and statement of unifying diagnosis- Clear contingencies and action items- Effective use of semantic qualifiers
Silver Standard	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Comprehensive and includes all I-PASS components but slightly disorganized (i.e., not adherent to format order)- No missing information- Small amount (1–2 items) of redundant or irrelevant information- Clear understanding and statement of unifying diagnosis at some point during the handoff- Contingencies are included but more vague- No semantic qualifiers
Bronze Standard	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Vague, disorganized- Missing 1 component of I-PASS- Missing at least 1 clinical data point- No statement of unifying diagnosis- Contingencies vague or absent
