



2022 CALL FOR LATE-BREAKING ABSTRACTS

The Council for the Advancement of Nursing Science (CANS) is now accepting late-breaking research abstracts for the 2022 State of the Science Congress
Social and Structural Determinants of Health

Conference Dates and Location

September 15 – 17, 2022: Grand Hyatt Washington DC

Conference Purpose

The 2022 State of the Science Congress on Nursing Research will expand participants' understanding of the complex relationships between social and structural determinants of health--from biology to policy--and nursing science. These relationships will be explored with respect to advancing health equity.

General Guidelines for Submission of Late-Breaking Abstracts

CANS is now accepting late-breaking abstracts for poster presentation at the 2022 State of the Science Congress. Late-breaking abstract submissions should exemplify novel research and data that were not previously available prior to the May 2 abstract submission deadline. Research must be complete. Priority will be given to abstracts that reflect the conference theme: *Social and Structural Determinants of Health*. Abstracts should clearly specify how the work contributes to the current state of nursing science. Submitted abstracts should include new, unpublished information that, at the time of submission, has not been presented at any level. If referencing previously published information, please indicate what information is novel.

Authors may submit multiple abstracts, including abstracts not directly related to the conference theme. Student submissions are encouraged and abstracts reporting literature reviews, systematic reviews, and/or conceptual frameworks related to the conference theme will be considered.

The abstract submission website for late-breaking abstracts will be open on June 6, 2022. You may edit your abstract through **June 27, 2022**. After June 27, 2022 at 11:59 pm ET, your abstract is considered final and will be reviewed based on the content provided.

The cost for submitting abstracts for peer review is \$90. There is no additional presentation fee if your abstract is accepted. You will also be required to register for the conference in order to present your abstract(s). Late-breaking abstracts will be considered for poster presentations. Posters will be displayed at a scheduled time during the conference, during which time you will be able to present your poster and engage in discussion and Q&A with attendees.

Your Abstract Should Include the Following Components:

Title: A brief statement of the nature of the investigation or purpose of the project.

Authors: All authors and affiliations.

Aims: The overall purpose or objective, question, or study hypothesis.

Methods: Describe the study or project design and methods (sample, procedures, measures, and/or data analysis). Please note that the study can use qualitative or quantitative methods.

Results: Discussion of research findings and products.

Conclusions: The overall impact of findings and relevance to conference theme of social and structural determinants of health in nursing, healthcare, or health policy.

The body of the abstract (aims through conclusions) is *limited to 250 words* in total. As part of the online submission process, presenters will be asked to select the content area(s) that best reflect their submission.

Review and Selection

The 2022 Abstract Review Committee will determine the final selection of abstracts based on scores and recommendations from peer reviewers.

Timeline

The online abstract submission process ends at 11:59 PM (EST) on June 27, 2022. The review process will take place in July.
