Electronic Submission

All submissions must be submitted electronically via the GEST Abstracts submission website. Paper or emailed submissions will not be accepted.

Financial Disclosure

The primary author will be required to complete a financial disclosure upon abstract acceptance. Industry employees cannot be presenters if the content of the abstract relates to the business lines and products of its employer.

Scientific Abstract (Oral or Electronic Poster):

A material that shows findings of a clinical research or basic science research which is completed based on testing a hypothesis and is being presented in the form of text, charts and/or figures.

- Follow the instructions listed for each relative section.

Accepted Abstracts

Oral Scientific Abstracts:

Selected abstracts will be chosen to be presented orally at GEST 2026. The primary author must register and attend the meeting in-person. Details on discounted registration will be provided upon acceptance notification.

Electronic Poster Scientific/Educational Abstracts:

Selected abstracts will be displayed as electronic posters at GEST 2026. The primary author must register and attend the meeting in-person.

All accepted Scientific and Educational Abstracts will be published in the July issue of JVIR (Journal of Vascular and Interventional Radiology). If you do not wish for your abstract to be published, you must withdraw it by the date indicated on the acceptance notification.

Awards

Oral Scientific Abstracts:

The top oral abstracts will be selected to present at GEST 2026 during the Best Scientific Abstracts session.

During the Best Scientific Abstracts session, the research committee will review all presentations and award the following at the end of the session:

First place award: \$5,000
Second place award: \$2,500
Third place award: \$1,250

Electronic Poster Scientific/Educational Abstracts:

All electronic posters will be judged by the research committee and the top three posters will be recognized at the Best Scientific Abstracts session. A certificate will be sent to awardees electronically after the conclusion of the meeting.
